Wisconsin Supreme Court to Review Medical Malpractice Caps Case

The state's Supreme Court agreed last week to review a lower court's decision striking down a cap on how much patients can receive for some malpractice claims.

An appeals court ruled in July that a state law capping awards for noneconomic damages at \$750,000 was unconstitutional. Noneconomic damages seek to compensate patients for pain and suffering.
